- d) Move the big front Rhododendrons to the background.
- e) Remove the 2 little tiny trees that don't "fit". Styrax trees.
- f) The landscape company (Bear Creek) provided a ballpark price for each line item, noting that selection of new plant species is to be determined.
- g) Shari pointed out that the first VERY NICE plants put into the front entrance, they were ALL STOLEN within the first week. Note that we've also had repeated vandalism of the landscape lighting and irrigation system.

Jennifer has registered a new domain name for our HOA, with GoDaddy. She'll submit the receipt to Carel, our Treasurer.
