IV. Current Financial Condition.

Jennifer Kuhtz presented the current year's budget and expenditures, pointing out any abnormalities that strayed from the prior years proposed budget. It was suggested that a budget line item be created to include yearly mulching. The 2020 budget was presented and Approved. The amount for the dues (\$380.00) in 2020 will remain unchanged. V. Open Business

Front Landscaping Plans: It was determined that no new landscaping changes were necessary.

VI. New Business

Mailboxes: At the request of a Quail Creek HOA member, the idea of HOA provided and maintained mailboxes was presented. The change in procedure would require an increase in yearly dues. After group discussion and vote, the proposal was declined.

Front Entrance Monument and Sign: The need for a new front sign and monument was presented to all attending members, including the estimate acquired for the replacement of just the sign. After lengthy discussion, it was determined that a sub-committee would be formed. The sub-committee will research the monument's current condition, design a new monument/sign, and collect several estimates to determine an approximate amount for future budget discussions.

Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CC&R): All attending members were notified that the current CC&R's are out of date. As a result, a sub-committee was formed to update and prepare new CC&R's.

Pet Waste Signage and Structures: It was proposed that the HOA purchase and install pet waste signs and disposable bag structures. A vote was conducted and the proposal was declined.

Elections: Two new Members at Large were motioned and approved.
