1. Prior Meeting Minutes

2. Financial Status

- Bear Creek Landscape costs came in a few hundred dollars over last year.
- Paid for cherry tree removal due to front entrance accident.

3. Front Entrance Accident

- Tree has been removed via Matt's Tree Service. Stump remains.
- Need to get a new tree. Estimate is in progress from Bear Creek Landscaping. We are also in discussions with Rich's Landscaping.
- We're unsure of the exact species of the tree to be replaced.
- We will have José O. work on removing the stump, with care to avoid existing irrigation lines.

4. Front Entrance Mulching & Barking

• Will investigate the front entrance barking, and will talk to José O. about doing this along with the stump removal. We'll consider Enrique as an alternate. Jamie will look into this.

5. QC05 Expansion & Shed

Discussed ongoing progress with this project. Nothing extraordinary to report.

6. QC18 Line-of-Sight Easement

- The arborvitae along the driveway for QC18 appears to conflict with the existing line-of-sight easement for the lot. The issue is that vehicles entering Quail Creek Drive from Quail Creek Way NE are blocked from viewing traffic traveling downhill (Westbound) on NE Quail Creek Dr.
- We will determine the impact on the existing line of arborvitae to give more information to the homeowner.
